General Information for previous WFTR Interns

What is an alumni?

WHO QUALIFIES:

An alumni of WFTR is a person who has previously completed any of our internships and successfully completed the alumni application process. There are three levels to our Alumni program; Level1 is for those who have completed an internship not in leadership, and Level2 (Alumni - Emerging Leaders) is for those who have completed a leadership internship that has required them to submit a dissertation and interact cross-generationally.

Level3 (Alumni Associates) is for those who have completed a leadership internship that has required them to submit a thesis and interact cross-culturally, cross-generationally, or cross-denominationally. These are leaders who are being established through experience under the covering of WFTR.

Alumni Associates must also have passed their internship with a final grade of “upper credit” or higher, or otherwise must be involved in some form of global/faith leadership for a minimum of 12 months.



CONDITIONS - STANDARD OF LIFE

There are some expectations an alumni must adhere to...

Level 1&2

- An alumni must be a part of a local church
 - An alumni must commit to participate in some form of initiative of WFTR at least once a year that requires them to come to the Rock House (for level 2 this must be either cross-generationally or cross-culturally)

Level 3

- An alumni associate must meet the expectations above and in addition be involved in some form of leadership role in the place they are now serving (cross-culturally, cross-generationally, cross-denominationally)





Conditions

CONTINUED...

- An alumni cannot come to live residentially at the Rock House; To live at the Rock House requires a person to be successfully accepted onto another form of residential internship, or...
- It is also possible for an alumni to come to the Rock House to serve as a staff person, this voluntary role is either as a global leader, or as a missionary. Contact link2body@wftherock.org for more information about the application process for staff members.

DISCOUNTS

Alumni receive the privilege of up to 50% discounts on WFTR initiatives

WORKSHOPS

Alumni can attend the JD Revolution and MYW for free when they bring another person to the workshop with an arrangement to follow them up with mentoring or discipleship (accommodation contributions still apply)*

ONLINE

Alumni can attend up to two WFTR online lectures/meetings each week.

The first must be in the area they qualified in (eg, ECL3 can attend ECL2&3 lectures but cannot cross over to MCI lectures).

ONLINE cont...

The second online lecture must be in an area they are coming to give into (eg, ManUWell core team, WWAY core team, MYW mentor/moderator, MCI 1-2 Facilitator, Aspire 1-3 coordinator, etc).

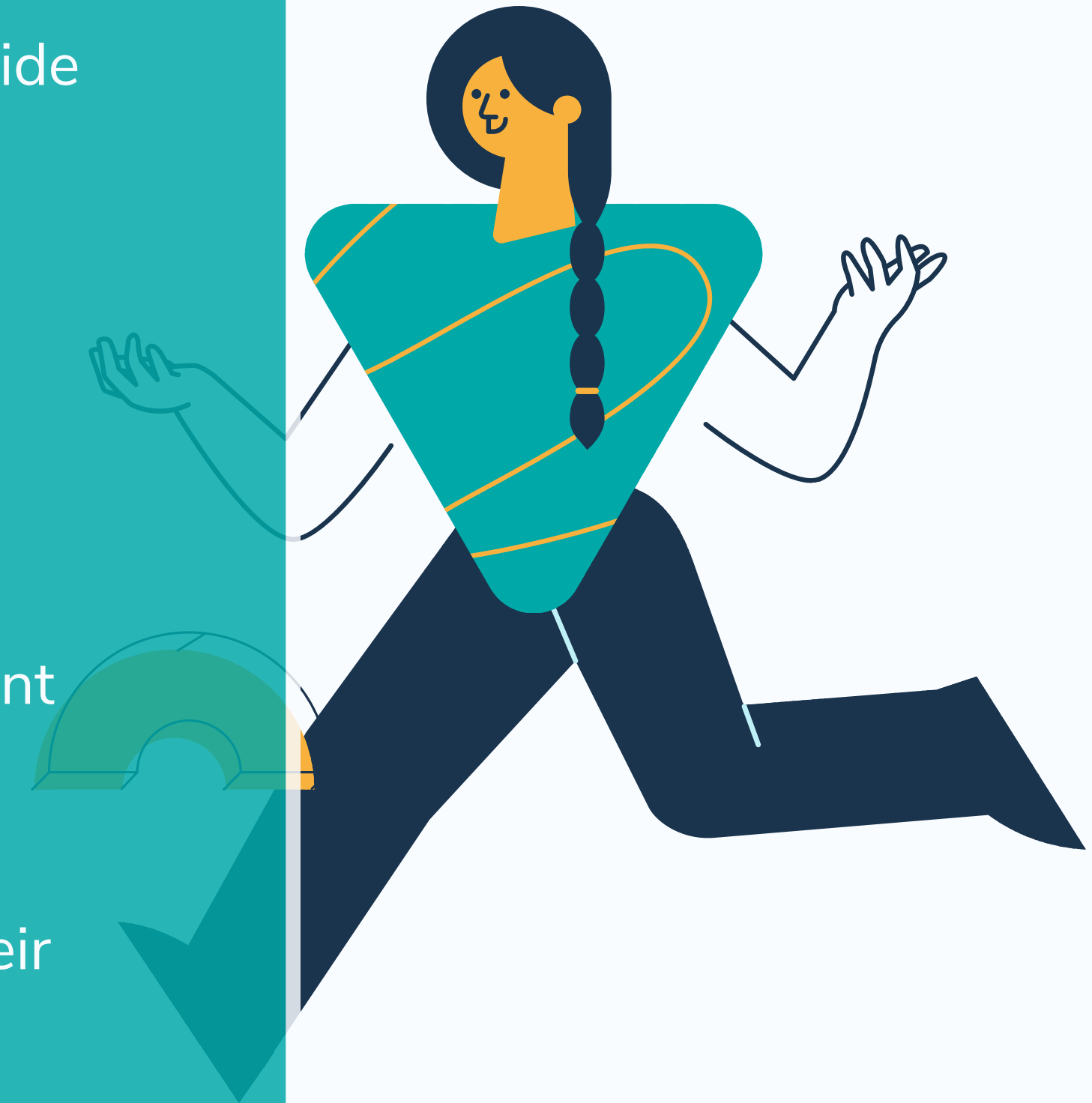
**Alumni benefits are valid for 1 year from date of acceptance*

For successful applicants...

Once an application is successful, we ask an alumni to provide us with relevant information about themselves that will appear on our alumni page at wftherock.org/alumni.

This information includes:

- A portrait photo of themselves
- A bullet-point summary of personal background info (age, country of origin, completed internship type, current status - eg, university student)
- And either an up to 150 words bio or 1 minute video telling about their internship journey/experience and their current interests (eg, supporting the poor in developing nations)
